

RoHS DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY
(EU Directives no. 2011/65, no. 2015/863 and no. 2017/2102)

RoHS Directive provides that electrical and electronic equipment shall not contain the substances listed in Annex II "Restricted substances referred to in Article 4(1) and their maximum concentrations values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials¹." The list of the substances is shown in the following table.

Subsequent delegated Directives modified the Annex III, about applications exempted from the restrictions pursuant to art. 4(1), and the Annex IV, about applications benefiting from an exemption from the art. 4(1) restriction of the RoHS Directive.

Pursuant to the foregoing, hereby Marcegaglia Fos-sur-Mer declares that all the products supplied comply with the limits established within the Annex II of RoHS Directive - "Restricted substances referred to in Article 4(1) and maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogenous materials".

¹ Art. 3 (20) of the EU Directive 2011/65 defines as homogenous a material of uniform composition throughout or a material consisting of a combination of materials that cannot be disjointed or separated into different materials by mechanical actions such as unscrewing, cutting, crushing, grinding and abrasive processes.
